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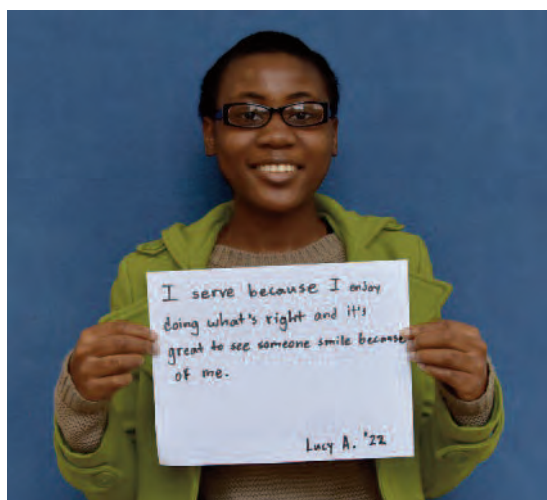
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"I SERVE BECAUSE..."

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FIVE DAYS, FOUR PROJECTS, 40 HOURS OF SERVICE

How do disasters – both large and small – challenge our notions of self and provide opportunities for growth? This was the question students sought to answer on the New Orleans service learning trip, “Responding to Disaster and Building Resiliency.” They examined the different phases of disaster response by volunteering in areas impacted by the August 2016 flooding and by Hurricane Katrina more than 10 years earlier. Students heard first-hand about the impacts of those disasters from survivors and relief workers, spoke with key stakeholders in the rebuilding process, and examined the social justice issues that have arisen as a result of Katrina’s devastation. Whether they were clearing tornado debris, painting a dance studio, or weeding and planting spring crops, students thought critically about what makes up a community and what it takes for a community to rebuild.

RIISING TO THE CHALLENGE

During the past six years, the Newark Academy community has come together to prepare NA for the future through a series of long-needed capital improvements and securing the school's future financial health by growing the endowment.

This investment in NA is completely funded through gifts to *Rise & Flourish*: The Campaign for Newark Academy, and to date, alumni, parents, faculty, staff, area foundations and others have given \$29 million in gifts and pledges. These gifts have enabled Newark Academy to construct a new Upper School Academic Center (opened in 2012), renovate its outdoor athletic facilities (completed in 2014), construct a new Middle School facility (opened in 2017) and create a \$5 million endowment for the Newark Scholars program. The final project of the campaign will be a renovation and expansion of Rose Auditorium.

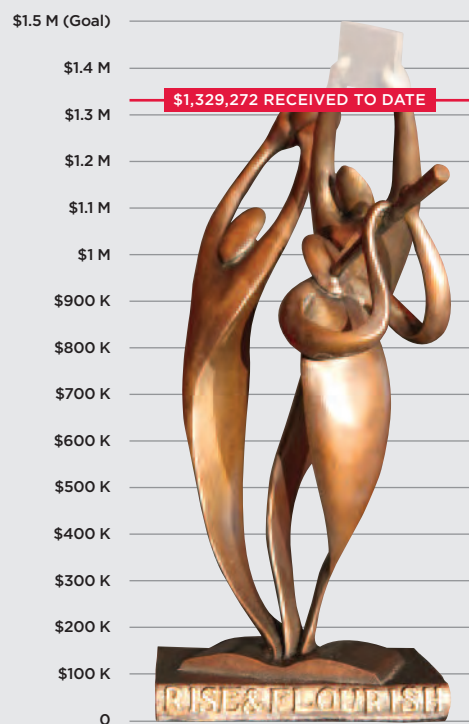
Every Dollar Matched in 2017!

Opening of the New Middle School

In April 2017, one year after the groundbreaking ceremony, Middle School students and faculty members moved into the nearly 22,000 square-foot, two-story structure. The completion of the Middle School building this year was a momentous occasion for the entire NA community. From the laying of the concrete foundation to erecting the steel framework to building the exterior brickwork and installing the windows – students, faculty and parents have witnessed the amazing daily changes that have taken place on campus this past year.

Inside, high ceilings and an abundance of windows create a light, open and inviting spaces for students that enhances their learning experiences. The collaborative environment is fueled by lecture-style seating and whiteboards in the classrooms. Students connect with their peers in a multi-purpose commons area and enjoy gathering in larger, bright spaces. Arts and music performances reach new heights thanks to the theater seating, and new science labs will better prepare students for Upper School.

Rose Auditorium: The Heart of Newark Academy

The fourth, and final phase of *Rise & Flourish*: The Campaign for Newark Academy, is the expansion and renovation of Rose Auditorium. The venue serves not only as a gathering place for the school, but also as a place where performing arts students can reach their creative potential. Built more than 50 years ago, in 1964, the auditorium has not kept pace in

terms of NA's enrollment growth or in the areas of acoustics, lighting and theatrical technology. For the past five years, Morning Meetings are standing room only and the increasingly talented NA students have seen performances limited by the quality of the facility. Additionally, the stage, light, acoustics and back-stage spaces need to be modernized with new technology and features. Now is the time to create a state-of-the-art performing arts space that will not only bring the entire community together in one place but will provide a venue for our performing arts students to truly shine!



NEWARK SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The Newark Scholars Program is an endowed fund, supported by numerous alumni, parents and grandparents which continues to provide full-ride plus scholarship packages for six of the best and brightest students from NA's founding city. Generous contributions to the program provided Newark Scholar Tiana Barkley '17 with an enhanced learning experience. In addition to excelling in the classroom, she was also a member of the NA Peer Leadership Program, an accomplished dancer and artist, and a member of the girls' varsity softball team. Tiana graduated from Newark Academy in June 2017 and attends George Washington University. 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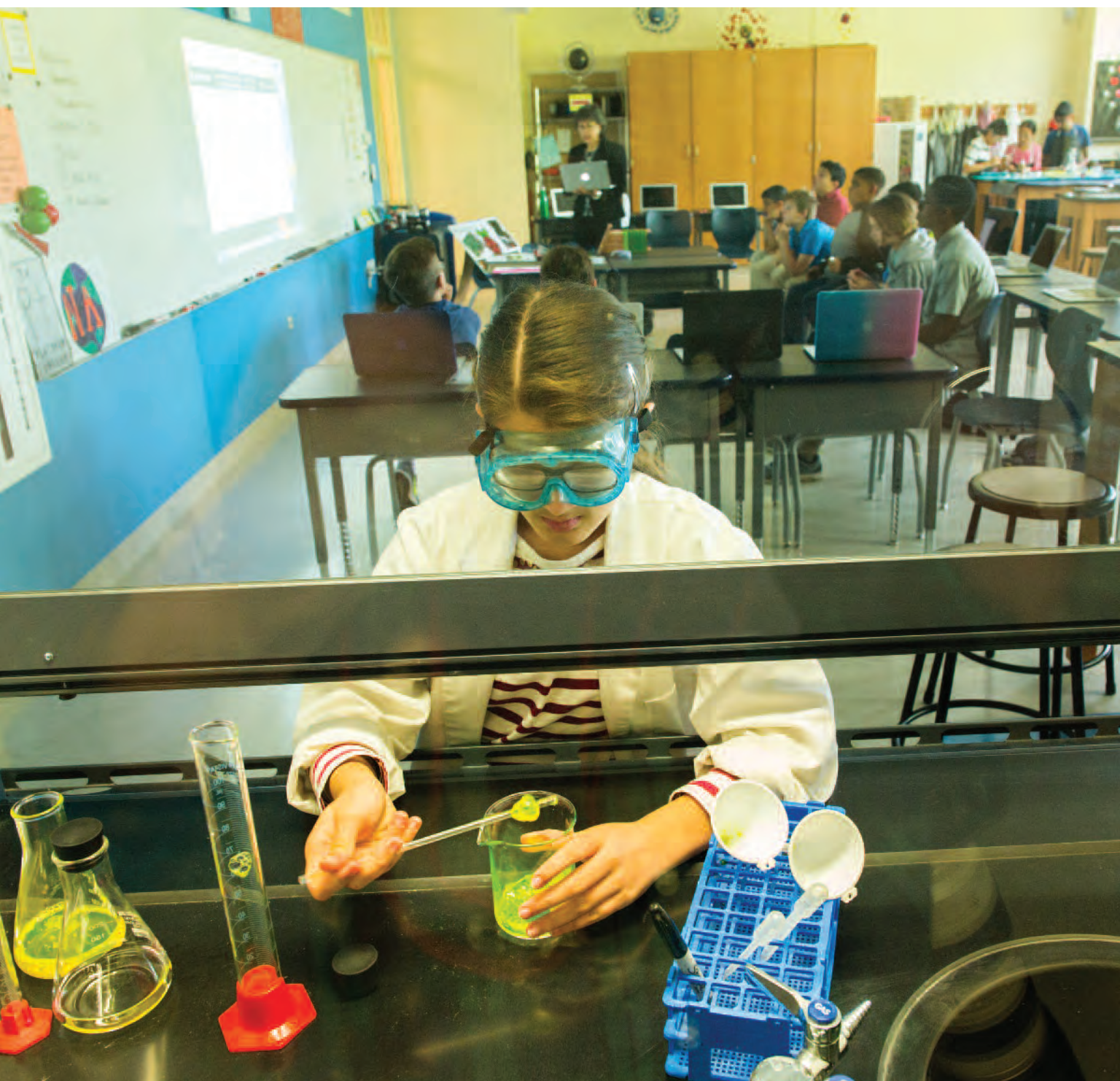

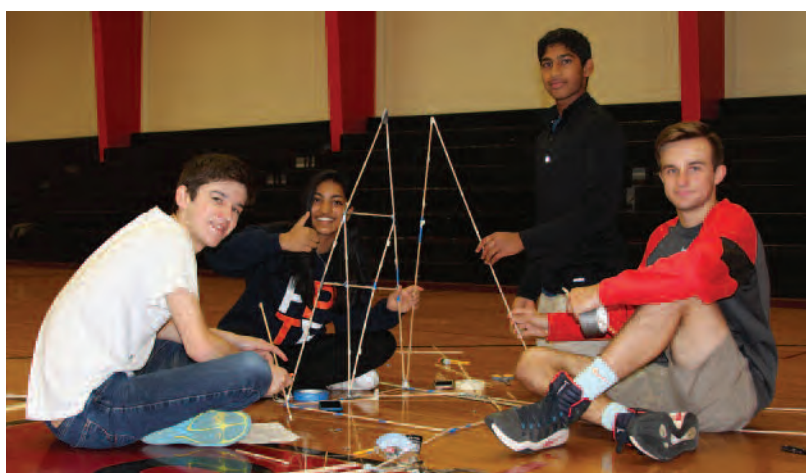

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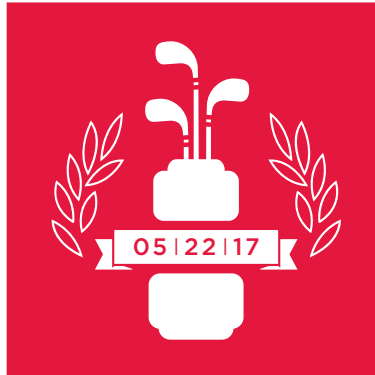
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MINUTEMAN GOLF INVITATIONAL
